

Medication Restrictions

Check with your Primary Care Provider (PCP) or surgeon about your medications and supplements prior to arrival; certain medications and supplements can cancel or delay your surgery.

Arrival Time for Surgery

Our staff will call you with your arrival time the workday prior to your sugery day. Please call 806.472.6812 with any questions.

We will provide you with your arrival time and detailed instructions on what time you need to stop eating and drinking.

Food and Drink Restrictions

Please follow our eating and drinking instructions exactly.

*Consuming food or liquids can delay or cancel your surgery for safety reasons.

Things to Avoid Before Arrival Contact Lenses Jewelry Perfume, body lotions, oils Makeup, false eyelashes Shaving Nail polish, acrylic nails Any personal items/valuables

Arrival

Your arrival time will typically be 1 to $2\frac{1}{2}$ hours prior to your surgery. This time before your surgery will be used to go over your health information and prepare you for surgery.

- Once you arrive, go to the Surgical Services reception desk to begin registration.
- After you have finished registering, you may go to the waiting area. A healthcare provider will be with you shortly.

Pre-op

Next, you will continue to your pre-op room.

- Please check with your nurse before using the restroom (a urine sample may be required).
- You will remove your clothing, perform a pre-op was, and then change into a patient gown and slipper socks.
- A registered nurse will review your health information and check your vitals. Lab work and testing may be performed.
- No more than *tw*o visitors will be able to wait with you.
- You will meet with the operating room team to review your health history and anesthesia plan.
- Once you are fully prepared, you will be escorted to the operating room. Anyone with you at this time will return to the waiting area.

Recovery

After your surgery, you will be taken to the recovery room.

- Once you are awake and comfortable, your nurse will provide you with visitor options.
- Your discharge time will depend on how you are feeling as you recover from anesthesia and by the type of surger you had.
- Once you are ready to go home, a nurse will go over your post-operative instructions and answer questions before you will be able to leave.
- Prescriptions can be filled or picked up at the Health & Wellness Pharmacy, located on the first floor. Refer to the green section of the map.

Making Arrangements

You will need to be supervised following anesthesia.

You will not be able to drive yourself home.

Even if you plan on using a ride-share app or taxi, you will need to bring someone along with you to make sure you get home safely.
